

Consultation on a proposed reduction in the published admission number (PAN) for Wilberforce Primary School, with effect from September 2021

Consultation period: 7th October – 18th November 2019

Specific Proposal

The Directors of the United Learning Academy Trust propose that the PAN at Wilberforce Primary School be reduced from 60 to 30 from September 2021.

This means that the number of places available for children in Reception in 2021 and all subsequent Reception cohorts – will be 30. For children who already have a place at the school in other year groups there will be no change. This is the only proposed change to the admission criteria, all other criteria, including oversubscription, will remain the same.

Who is consulted?

This consultation is for the attention of:

- a) Parents of children between the ages of two and eleven years old at the school currently and in the surrounding area;
- b) Other persons in the area who have an interest in the proposed arrangements;
- c) All other admission authorities within the local area;
- d) The local authority; and
- e) Adjoining neighbouring local authorities.

How to respond

This consultation will end at 5pm on the 18th of November – please send any comments regarding this change before that time.

Following the consultation period the Governing Body will consider any comments received and how to proceed. Admissions arrangements for September 2021 will be determined by 28th February 2020 and published on the school and council website by 15th March 2020. Any subsequent objections after publication should be made to the Office of the Schools Adjudicator by 15th May 2020.
